

Religious Education at Western

At Western our children engage in learning about faith and spiritually by using their naturally enquiring minds.



In Early Years this might involve sharing special books and stories and beginning to understand and appreciate our different beliefs and how we celebrate festivals.



In Key stage 1 this would involve looking at ‘Big Questions’ and where can we find the answers as well as celebrating religious festivals and visiting religious buildings.



In Key stage 2 we start to look at life as a journey and expand our knowledge of religious texts and beliefs and how they are relevant today.



At each stage the children learn to respect other cultures which encourages tolerance and leads them to asking questions about their own beliefs.



The whole school takes part in events such as the Multi Faith Day and our Harvest Collection for the Harrogate Food Bank.
