Literacy

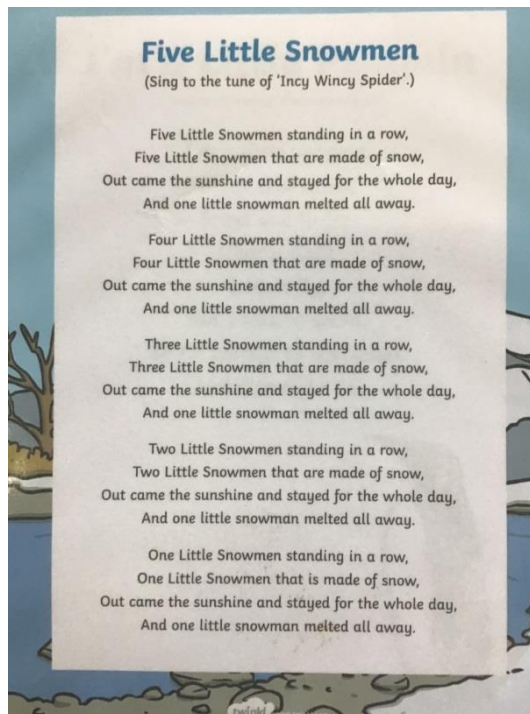
Listen to the story Penguin and The Magic Sky on Tapestry.
