We would like to outline our provision for your child's remote learning, starting tomorrow and ending on Monday afternoon next week.

Mrs Coatesworth, Mrs Edwards and Mrs Strong will be working at home. Showbie will continue to be used as a teaching and learning tool to enable them to access and upload their work from home.

Afternoon Work

In the afternoons, we would like the children to complete the following:

- Reading Plus for 30 mins.
- Times tables practice for 30 mins.
- Spelling Frame for 30 mins.

- Mini Topic work: We would like you to pick a country taking part in the Olympics. Find out lots of information about that country and prepare a keynote presentation. Include photos, facts and fun facts. (This can be done over a few days).

Our remote learning will follow this format:

- Each day, your child will be asked to join all Zoom lessons and a register will be taken.
- The Zoom code and password will be the same each day.
- Work will be marked by Teachers/TAs each day between the hours of 9am -3.15pm. Teachers/TAs will be able to remotely mark work via their Showbie account.
- A separate email address for Year 3/4 is still available should parents have any questions or queries regarding the Showbie tasks. A member of the team will respond, as soon as possible, to your query between the hours of 9am and 3.15pm. If you have a question or need to pass on information relating to an individual child, then email the team:
